

## 1 Preview Server 4.6.0

Release Date: 2023-01-16

These are the release notes for Preview Server 4.6.0. This document describes the user-visible changes that have been made to the software since version 4.5.0.

Preview Server manages the pool of Viz Engines that serve up snapshots of graphics to client software such as Viz Multichannel, Viz Pilot, and Viz Trio.

## 1.1 New Features

· Some limited adaptive graphics support (FS-479).

### 1.2 Fixed Issues

- Sometimes graphics from the wrong scene would be returned when multiple clients connected simultaneously (FS-477, FS-497).
- Preview Server now works when the control object in the scene is called something different from "Object" (FS-480).

### 1.3 Installation

- The latest installer is on download.vizrt.com at /products/ VizPreviewServerConnectionBroker/LatestVersion.
- The configuration file 'PreviewServer.exe.config' is located in the installation directory (default: C:\Program Files (x86)\Vizrt\Preview Server).

## 1.4 Upgrading

- The Windows .exe installer is able to upgrade previous installations to the 4.6.0 version automatically.
- · Main testing of Preview Server 4.6.0 has been performed on Windows 10.

### 1.5.1 Recommended

- · Windows 10
- · MS .NET Framework 4.6.2 or later

## 1.5.2 Minimum

- · Windows 7
- · MS .NET Framework 4.6.2
