1.4.1 Migrating from Viz Multichannel 4.2.x to Channel Branding 5.0+

1. Uninstall previous version.
 2. Install Viz Channel Branding 5.0 component 'Upgrade Tool'
 3. Run 'Upgrade Tool' and 'Migrate' and then 'Upgrade' appropriate channels - it is a two-step process, one data migration-step step and one final data-upgrade pass
