1.1 Improvements

- Order Number handling has been improved and does not have to be changed on each renewal (T-164049).
 - Updated the loading symbols to match Vizrt branding (T-164034).
 - Removed the “Cancellation Until” column from the License Admin view as it was a duplicate of the “End Date” column (T-164036).
 - The text on the column visibility button has been changed in the License View (T-164038).
 - Added an additional download option that allows creation of a License Container in an offline virtual environment (T-164029).

- Fixed an issue where hitting the Enter Key during license creation immediately created the license (T-163061).
- Fixed an issue where the Auto Update function was not working on Cloud / VM Environments (T-157452).
- Fixed issue where it was not possible to change all features during license creation (T-164032).

2.1 Improvements

- The function buttons on the Admin Page have been moved from the Licenses section to the top (T-163064).
 - The default value for newly created licenses is set to "network" (T-163066).
 - The OrderID of the previous order is now displayed during the license renewal (T-163071).
 - The buttons in the Ticket section have been redesigned (T-163069).
 - The toggle between Online and Offline License Activation has a renamed button to match Vizrt's terminology (T-163067).

- Fixed an issue where the displayed expiration date was one year after the actual expiration date (T-163099).
- Fixed an issue where it was possible to create a license without selecting an expiration date (T-163062).

These are the release notes for Vizrt Licensing version 3.1.0. This document describes the user-visible changes that have been done to the software since release 3.0.0.

3.1 Improvements

- Implemented an Activation Summary Page during Activation/Auto Update.
 - Added a column visibility selector to the licenses page.
 - Added filter options to the licenses page.
 - Added the information about the ticket source to the Containers tab.
 - Added Drop-Down-Option to open and close individual containers to improve visibility.
 - Moved the Account Information to a separate menu.
 - Function buttons (Activate License, Auto Update,...) on the Licenses Page, are greyed instead of not displayed, if no license is available to use this function.
 - Added tooltips.
 - Simplified UI.
 - Updated the color scheme.
 - Updated the Vizrt logo.

3.2 Fixed Issues

- Fixed issue where the License Quantity was not displayed.
 - Fixed issue where the License Expiration Date was not shown correctly.
 - Fixed issue where the "Select All" Checkbox stayed selected when removing the filter during activation.
 - Fixed issue that kept refreshing the browser on the licenses page when the CodeMeter Runtime software was not installed locally.
 - Fixed issue that caused old Permanent License features to restore the complete history of the license dongle / Software Container.
 - Fixed issue where the previously used "Reset Feature" restored the complete history of the license dongle / Software Container.
